Regarding the Protection of Personal Information

The Company hereby establishes the following Privacy Policy and strives to ensure the appropriate handling, management, and maintenance of personal information.

Privacy Policy

- 1. The Company will comply with all applicable laws, regulations, guidelines, contractual obligations, and internal rules related to the protection of personal information, and will ensure the proper use and management of such information.

- 4. The Company will take reasonable measures to prevent unauthorized use, access, loss, destruction, falsification, or leakage of personal information under its management, and will implement corrective and preventive actions as necessary. The Company will also establish standards for and appropriately supervise contractors entrusted with handling personal information.
- 5. The Company will conduct regular self-inspections regarding personal information protection, evaluate and improve compliance with relevant laws, regulations, guidelines, contractual obligations, and internal rules, and strive to enhance the effectiveness and reliability of its measures through preventive and corrective actions.
- The Company will continuously improve its personal information protection management methods, taking into consideration changes in external environments such as information technology and social trends, as well as internal organizational changes.
- 7. In the event of any act in violation of applicable laws, regulations, guidelines, contractual obligations, or internal rules related to personal information protection, the Company will take disciplinary action in accordance with the provisions of its employment regulations.
